**ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**Q. My entire team is coming to the camp, is their a group discount?**

*The Al Golden Football Camp is already the most inexpensive Division I football camp in America. Our low price of \$55 and the additional day you get with the Diamond Street Double are designed with the team in mind!*

**Q. What should I bring to camp and will their be facilities to dress in the morning?**

*Please come dressed for the days activities – space is a premium in our locker room. You are advised to wear clothes that will be able to keep you comfortable in the warm weather of Philadelphia during this time of year! Wear workout clothes and bring BOTH sneakers and football cleats. Sneakers are required for use on Geasey Field (turf). This is a non-contact camp; no helmets/shoulder pads are needed. Please do not bring personal items such as footballs, ipods, or any other valuables to camp. The AL GOLDEN FOOTBALL CAMP, LLC is not responsible for any lost or stolen property.*

**Q. Should I bring money?**

*There will be a camp store selling drinks and snacks during the day. Also, lunch is NOT included in the cost of camp; however, you will be able to pre pay for lunch during registration. For just \$7 you will have the opportunity to dine in our newly renovated J&H Café with a BBQ style menu and unlimited drink! Parents, should you choose to stay; you also will be able to purchase lunch. Q. I'm a parent and would like to watch the activities of the day, is there a place for me to observe the camp?*

**DIRECTIONS TO EDBERG-OLSON HALL**

**From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:**

Take Exit 326 (Philadelphia/Valley Forge). Follow I-76 East (Schuylkill Expy.) approx. 18 miles to Exit 344 (Central Philadelphia/I-676) Note: Exit is on left. Follow I-676 approx. 1 mile to Central Phila./Broad Street exit. Take Broad St. exit (stay to left). In one block go left onto Broad St. Follow Broad St. to Diamond St. (approx. 2 miles). Turn right onto Diamond St. The complex is between 11<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Streets on Diamond. Visitors Parking Lot 10 entrance is on right between 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Streets.

**From the Northeast Extension/Pennsylvania Turnpike:**

Take Exit 20 to I-476 South to I-76 East. Exit at I-76 East (approx. 5 miles). Take I-76 East approx. 15 miles to Exit 344 (Central Philadelphia/I-676). Note Exit is on left. Follow directions from I-676 above.

**From I-95 North:**

Take Exit 22 (Central Philadelphia/I-676). Follow Central Philadelphia signs to Broad Street exit. At next intersection (Vine St.) turn left. In one block, turn left onto Broad Street. Follow Broad St. to Diamond St. (approx. 2 miles). Turn right onto Diamond Street. The complex is between 11<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Streets on Diamond. Visitors Parking Lot 10 entrance is on right between 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Streets.

**From I-95 South:**

Take Exit 22 (Central Philadelphia/I-676). Note: left lane exit. I-676 West to Broad Street exit. See above directions from Broad Street exit.

**From the New York/New Jersey Area:**

Take New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 4 to Route 73 North. Approx. 1 mile to Route 38 West. Follow for 5 ½ miles to Benjamin Franklin Bridge. Take I-676 West to Broad Street exit. Follow above directions from Broad Street exit.

**Public Transportation to Temple's Main Campus**

All lines stop at Temple University Station, 10<sup>th</sup> and Berks Streets. Broad St. Subway: All local trains stop at Cecil B. Moore Station (Broad St. and Cecil B. Moore Ave).

"C" Bus: Stops on Broad St. at Diamond St.

"3" Bus: Stops on Cecil B. Moore Ave from 11<sup>th</sup> St. to Broad St.

"23" Bus: Stops on 12<sup>th</sup> St. (Southbound) and 11<sup>th</sup> St. (Northbound) at Diamond St.
